

Plizzel Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q - Why are players of the Plizzel Game required to play after they start the game?

A - Actually, they are not required to play. But, because this is a life skill game, like life, if you don't participate you can't win. We give small Slacker Bump penalties along with reminders to players that neglect their chosen Plizzel Matrix.

Q - Can I still play Plizzel?

A - Yes! Once you become a Plizzel player your account stays open even if there is a zero balance. You never go in the hole as long as you maintain your Plizzel Game Software.

Q - What does Plizzel charge to stay in the game?

A - Only your monthly subscription fee depending on which Plizzel Matrix you have chosen.

Q - Can I set up my own Plizzel Matrix, with my own rules and payout structure?

A - Yes! We will encourage you to do that once you have reached the "Grand Master" level and we will give you full support in developing your personalized Plizzel Matrix through forums and chat rooms on the Plizzel Browser and web sites.

Q - Is it legal for me to play Plizzel anywhere?

A - As of now, yes! But beware of anything the government does in the future. They love sticking their nose in everyone's business, especially if they aren't using government help. Just pay all your taxes and maybe they will leave us alone. If they don't, at least we will have an educated group to fight back with should something come along to harm us.

Q - Can Plizzel improve my odds of winning?

A - Every step of the way in the game is a lesson to show you how to win as quickly as possible. This is our main purpose in the game's design.

Q - How can I make money building a business while building my team of players at the same time?

A - Every Player using the Plizzel Management Software (PMS) has the option to become an Independent Marketing Representative (IMR) by choosing a Plizzel Matrix in the upper Plizzel Matrix level. Each IMR receives a more feature-rich version of the PMS application, while also gaining access to important online marketing tools to assist with growing their business and increasing the number of players in their Matrix. For example in the \$25 Matrix a \$5.00 ongoing commission is paid for each personal subscription enrolled by an IMR. Each IMR can qualify for management override bonuses paid through seven Levels of players who join their Plizzel Matrix. The commissions and override bonuses are paid for each play period a Player or IMR renews the PMS subscription. Plizzel is the smart way to play and use your weisure time properly.

Q - Nobody referred me to Plizzel. I found your site while surfing the internet. If I play, who shares in the override bonuses?

A - There is a part of the game that is a little like a lottery. The Players choose a Whimster when first becoming a Player or IMR. The winning Whimster group will be assigned this type of player and then some questions will be sent to this group until a winner is determined by their answers. The new Player is then placed in the Matrix at this point.

Q - What is a Direct Referral Line, and how does it affect my share of winning?

A - The Direct Referral line is when a Player or IMR markets a product or service outside any of the Plizzel Matrixes without that person or company becoming a Player or IMR in the Plizzel Games. The winnings or commissions will be added to your Plizzel account and not shared with your up line or down line. It will count for your overall total.

Q - How and when do I receive the products or service I purchased?

A - Each product or service will have posted terms and conditions to review before you commit to any action.

Q - Why does it take time for my selections to become active?

A - Some selections are immediate and others are determined by market, shipping or technical matters. Plizzel will maintain both a tracking system and help section on the Plizzel Browser and the Web Sites.

Q - Can I join by mail or phone?

A - Yes, if you set up an account with Plizzel? This information will be on the Plizzel Browser and the Plizzel web sites.

Q - Are product and services available on a subscription basis?

A - Everything we do in the Plizzel Matrixes is available on a subscription basis and Players and IMR's are encouraged to take advantage of this service.

Q - Does Plizzel market products or services directly through the company?

A - No! Our only product is our software for Players and IMR's.

Q - I want to play in more than one Matrix. Can I do that?

A - Yes! In fact, that is the point of the whole Plizzel Game. Master all of the Matrixes and you will have solved most of your individual financial problems forever.

Q - Why does Plizzel impose a \$25 per month licensing fee for each Matrix?

A - This fee covers the leveraging Matrix for each situation. Most of it is passed on to the Players and IMR's.

Q - What is the refund policy for Plizzel?

A - Plizzel is committed to exceptional customer services in all of our dealings. Should a subscriber to the Plizzel Management Software desire to cancel their service and receive a refund, the user first submits a written notification. They are eligible for a 100% refund of the latest month's subscription cost. Only the cost of goods or services will not be available for a full refund.

Q - As an Independent Marketing Representative (IMR) do I receive a check each month for the commissions and override bonuses due me?

A - All IMRs must utilize a third-party financial services company, PayPal or any other financial service company contracted with Plizzel for the electronic transfer of any winnings, commissions or override bonuses due to them.

Q - Is there any charge for the International Payout Systems services?

A - Yes, there are monthly "banking" fee for the IPS services.

Q - When are winnings, commissions or override bonuses paid?

A - Winnings, commissions and override bonuses earned are calculated on the last Monday of each month. At that time, all funds are transferred into an IMR's v-Wallet. An Independent Marketing Representative (IMR) can request funds, at any time. Plizzel pays Withdrawal Requests on the first or third Monday of each month. If any of the above days fall on a recognized holiday, requests for payouts will be processed on the following business day.

Q - What about children's policy?

A - Everything negative concerning children is separated clearly and requires an adult registration. See the Plizzel Privacy Policy on the site for the details. You can still play but only in sections that are appropriate. We are very careful. In fact educational about the content. The Plizzel Privacy Policy is available for you when you play. We are hoping to attract young players. Slacker Bumps penalize and train young players if they try to access any information not appropriate for their age. See the Plizzel Privacy Policy.

Q - Is there a registration requirement with Plizzel?

A - Yes! Both Players and IMR's are required to registered because of financial disclosure laws that you and Plizzel must comply with to stay out of legal trouble. These disclosures are just the basics and we make sure your information is safe. You should read the Plizzel Privacy Policy on the site if you are concerned. Go to the site and download or just read the Plizzel Privacy Policy if you are concerned. You'll see your information is safe.

Q - How does Plizzel use my personal information?

A - By knowing a little about you, Plizzel is able to deliver more relevant content and a better service to you. Only Plizzel and your chosen Matrix Provider has access to individuals' accounts. Telephone numbers and e-mail addresses will only be used to contact you regarding winning something in the game or contest or to notify you of personal account information or deliveries by Matrix Providers.

Q - I don't understand the Plizzel Matrix. Can you explain it to me?

A - Each Matrix is different but basically it is the amount of reward or "Plash" won in the game by bringing in new players and IMR's. If you are in either the Upper Matrix or Lower Matrix you have amounts that you receive based on your finding and training other game players and IMR's. (Independent Marketing Representatives). You get credit for bringing in others according to the design of the Matrix.

Q - What about these adult and gambling Matrixes. Do I have to use them?

A - No! These can cause you to have Slacker Bumps. These are penalty payments in Plash. You would rather go to other Plizzel Matrixes, right? But some people are doing this anyway and this is just a better way of dealing with their addiction. They are just there as examples of Negative Capitalism. The point of Plizzel is to use Positive Capitalism to win.

Q - I don't want to sell pens. Can I still play Plizzel?

A - Of course. Just pick a Matrix that you feel you can handle. In fact, let them pick what they want. You aren't selling pens. You are only introducing people to the Matrix. It's their job to pick the Matrix that is best for them. You need to play Plizzel anyway you want to win. We can only give you options. Just get a copy of the Plizzel manual and it will help you win.

Q - Is there anything special I should know before I start playing Plizzel?

A - Just basic computer skills will get you through the game. It would be good if you know about business methods. If you can, start out as an IMR+. You'll see what that is on the web site.

Q - What are the technical requirement to play Plizzel?

A - You need either a computer, a phone, a PDA or any way to hook up to the Internet. That's all you need. Any Internet Device.

Q - How do I play Plizzel?

A - Just become a player and a big part of the game is teaching you how to play Plizzel.
